- 11 out of the 13 students in Kinder made positive gains of one or more points between October, November, December, and January 2019 as compared to benchmark September data in ELA between BOY and MOY as measured by iStation.
- 11 out of the 12 students in 1st Grade made positive gains of two or more points between October, November, December, and January 2019 as compared to benchmark September data in ELA between BOY and MOY as measured by iStation.
- 21 out of the 22 students in 2nd Grade made positive gains of one or more points between October, November, December, and January 2019 as compared to benchmark September data in ELA between BOY and MOY as measured by iStation.
- 11 out of the 14 students in 3rd Grade made positive gains of two or more points between October, November, December, and January 2019 as compared to benchmark September data in ELA between BOY and MOY as measured by iStation.
