Dear Parents, Guardians, Grandparents, and Community Members:

As of today, we have 52 elementary school students enrolled for the K3Plus, 4th, and 5th Grade. We extend our appreciation to you for registering your child/ren for summer school at Naschitti Elementary School.

As mentioned in an earlier parent letter sent home this week, we are pleased to inform you about upcoming events for your child. The events include Student Fieldtrips, Parent Involvement Day, and Student Celebration.

There is a stipulation for your child to attend the Fieldtrips. The K-5 Fieldtrips are scheduled on July 7th, 2016 and July 14th, 2016. Please be informed about the following stipulation.

Students must have a 95% attendance rate (missing only one day) during the K3Plus program from the date of their enrollment to attend the July 7th fieldtrip to Farmington. Students must also have a 90% attendance rate (missing no more than two days) during the K3Plus program from the date of their enrollment to attend the July 14th field trip to Gallup.

We have scheduled a Parent Involvement Day in the classroom as well. The Parent Involvement Day will take place on Thursday, July 21st, 2016 from 9 am to 11:30 am. You are invited to attend your child's class during this time to witness the instructional learning that takes place in the classroom. Please be advised to sign-in at the front office when you visit anytime during work hours.

The Student Celebration had been scheduled on July 27th, 2016, which is the last day of the K3Plus program at the Naschitti Elementary School gymnasium. This will take place at 9:30 am. Students will be recognized for their academic performance and attendance.

Be informed about the no-school days on July 4th, July 5th, and July 12th. Again, thank you for sending your child to summer school on a daily basis from Monday to Thursday. The last day to register a student for summer school is on **Tuesday, June 28th, 2016**. Also, be reminded to pick up your child at the PM bus stop for safety measures.
